She shared that the arrows were the prayers of all who were praying as the teams went out, and they arrows protecting those of the team going 'out on the doors' Thank you all for your prayers.

Text message received on Sunday after the team had visited on the previous Thursday Just to let you know we have just had a visit from a neighbour whom you had visited. He came to share of his healing when his leg grew and his back pain all went. He's so excited, and a changed man, how brilliant he came to share with us.

The lady refused all that was offered, and when asked stated that her religion was the worship of mother earth and nature. Keith replied 'oh so you are into witchcraft?' Whilst working in the same area two days later, the lady was again driving past when she stopped her car shouted

again, and threatened Keith that she had informed the police and was writing to the local paper.
