



### God at work in Heamoor

The work of Bible delivery, with Light and Life church Penzance, in Heamoor has been underway for three weeks at the time of writing this newsletter, and it has been amazing what the Lord has been doing.

It has been a real struggle for most members of the team in all sorts of different ways, but the work the Lord has been doing has blessed beyond measure. At one point the Lord reminded the team of the verse in Daniel 7 which states that one of the works of the enemy was to seek to **wear down the saints**. This has been something we had found but praise God the encouragements have abounded.

Before beginning the work in Heamoor the Lord gave Keith a picture of a cross coming to earth, and planting firmly into the ground of Heamoor. At this point Jesus descended and began to visit different homes. We believed the Lord was reminding us of the centrality of the cross and that He, Himself, would be going before us and supernaturally visiting homes in the area.

We would like to share some of the visits the different teams experienced. One of the first homes which was visited the gentleman who opened the door listened politely to Keith sharing his testimony and then the man said

“ Would you like to hear how I met Jesus, He called my name in the night, and I thought my mum had called me. My vicar told me about the boy called Samuel in the Bible.

Another team of Andy and Fernando were visiting in another place and they found a gentleman working the garden.



They asked if he was the home owner, and he told them he was only doing the garden but the owners were out. They started to share with him, but he quickly retorted that for what he had been through in his life he did not want to know about God. They continued to talk and he collected his tools and went around the back of the house.

They moved onto the next home when Andy heard the Lord say ‘it is grief’. Andy remembered that we had a booklet ‘When will the pain end’ which was for people with problems with grief. He went back and called but the man did not appear and so Andy left the booklet on a stone and went back to further doors.

A little time later the man who had been gardening drove out of the property and when his car was level with where Andy and Fernando were, the man opened his window and said,

“ I will read it , I will read it”

The elderly couple went on to tell that they had been watching Songs of Praise on the television and that it had really been touching their hearts, and Keith and Pat were able to lead them both in a prayer asking Jesus to forgive their sins and come into their lives.

That is just a couple of the amazing things Jesus has been doing in Heamoor. **We have a real sense of the fact that the Lord is at work in our nation at this time and it is important that, we His people, are available to do whatever He tells us.**
