Land's End to John O'Groats,
and back!!!!



The first photo was taken as we set out from Land's End on Wednesday April the 1st, and the second photo was taken



as we arrived at John O'Groats



on Sunday April the 12th, and planted a Bible at the most north-easterly point of the United Kingdom, and then blew a clarion call over the land. The final photo shows us returned to Land's End on Monday May the 4th where we declared the truth that the Lord reigns over the land, the glorious promises of **Isaiah 61**, and the planting of a little soil from John O'Groats.

The whole trip took **34 days** and out of those 34 days KnP **slept in 22 different venues.**

The venues included beds in homes, lay-byes, Campsites, church car parks, industrial estates, loch sides, and house fronts. All in safety and with little or no disturbance.

Keith **preached in 8 different places**, also sharing at other house groups. KnP were able to visit all the places outside Cornwall where they have been to take the 5 week, Acts 1:8 training.

KnP **covered 2567 miles** in their own vehicles and one or two miles in other peoples vehicles.

They were blessed with great scenery, really good weather, and fantastic company as they called at different venues; also a marvellously warm welcome wherever they went.

Pauline Sharing the Story.

A little while before we were setting out to go to John O'Groats we attended a day of meetings at Escalls Chapel led by a team from Ffald-y-Brenin. During the course of the day one of the ladies blew the shofar, and after the meeting Keith said he had heard the Lord say that the blowing of the shofar was a **clarion call.**

I looked up the dictionary definition of **clarion call.** A **clarion** was a **shrill, narrow tubed, war trumpet.** The word **clarion** now means **loud and clear**, and a **clarion call** is a

**strongly expressed demand or
request for action.**

We were very encouraged with these explanations as they fitted into what the Lord was telling us to do on this journey. We were going across the land singing His praises, and declaring the truth that we are at war, but that we will see the victory as we take the Good News of Jesus out into our land.

We were also making a strongly expressed request for the Lord to move in salvation power once again in our land.

We began our journey at Land's End and were encouraged to have a 'shoal' of Salmon (7), and a dog, from where we are blessed to have our van parked in Cornwall, and Mary from Escalls Chapel to pray for us and wish us God's blessing on our journey.

It would take far too long to share all that we did along the way and the numerous people we were blessed to fellowship with, but we would like to share with you some of the major highlights which we experienced as the Lord worked many wonders amongst us. There were times when the Lord spoke specifically to us and there were so many times when we saw the truth of the scripture in **Proverbs 3 v 6 'commit your way to the Lord and He will direct your paths.**

Our first stopping place was Church in the House Bible study group in Camelford, and we had a good time sharing with the group there, but sadly one of the leaders of the group had gone to a funeral. Ken McLeod, as his name would suggest is from Scotland, in fact, Dingwall in the Highlands. We were encouraged when he arrived home later that evening and the next day Keith asked him to

pray over 3 stones we had brought from Land's End in order to plant with the Bible at John O'Groats. Ken prayed with the fervour of a Highland warrior, but for unity within the United Kingdom and a destruction of division in state, church and among Christians.

At each place we stopped on the upward journey we blew the shofar as a symbol of the desire to see the Lord visit our land once again with salvation.

We meandered our way up to Burton, and then April the 8th we headed purposefully up to Loch Lomond. We blew the shofar at the border and prayed, we blew the shofar over Glasgow and prayed again. We are at present known as the United Kingdom and we prayed that prior to this time of election we would remain united in Jesus and receive a government which would be the best government for the spreading the Good News of Jesus.

We were blessed to spend a couple of days camped next to two beautiful lochs, Loch Lomond and Loch Leven. To see the snow upon the mountain tops and the quiet of the waters as the lochs rippled by us.

It was an important reminder of the need to 'come by the quiet waters', and to let the Shepherd guide us in every way. We were in awe of the splendour and majesty of the scenery we were passing through, but even more amazing that we were in personal contact with the One who made it all!

The previous summer we had met up again with a couple who Keith had led to the Lord in Hayle and who had allowed us to use their summer house to work from. We met up with them for coffee in Sainsbury's in Penzance

(note not Costa!), and as we were sharing about going to John O'Groats they told us they had a home less than 3 miles from John O'Groats and we would be welcome to stay with them, and park on their land. We arrived on Saturday the 11th and spent an enjoyable day with them, parking for the night, and then setting off for the most north-easterly point of the United Kingdom on the Sunday morning.

Having arrived at Duncansby Head lighthouse we scrambled down a slope; as near to the edge as we were able to go! Keith dug a hole and planted the Bible and the 3 stones from Land's End. We had informed the Shekinah Church in Penzance that we intended to blow the shofar, to declare a clarion call over the land, at 11am, and in line with a prophetic word they had received from Martin Scott many years previously, they said they would raise a shout at the same time in Penzance. It was exhilarating to know that as the shofar was blown in the most north-easterly point a shout for God's glory was raised in the south westerly point and all of us were asking the Lord to come and fulfil His word in our land.

From John O'Groats we travelled along the 'top' of Scotland, and then dropped down on the 'A' road towards Altnaharra. Once again there was a quantity of snow on the tops of the mountains, and as we went further along the single track, with passing places, main road, Keith was convinced I was leading along a side track! He drove well and we arrived for a couple of days at the camping site at the side of Loch Naver, one of the only two camping sites we used during the trip. The following morning as Keith was stood by the side of the loch, he heard the Lord speak to

him through the gentle rippling of the waves, made by the wind, upon the loch. The Lord said you can hear the sound of the gentle ripples of the wind upon the water; so I am coming with the wind of my Spirit and you will hear His sound.

By April the 15th we were back to close to the Scotland/England border, and that night Keith heard the Lord speaking to him about some praying to be done at the border. He heard the Lord tell him to symbolically unlock the border that the stream of His Spirit would flow throughout our land in salvation.

Keith was to use his staff to 'hit the rock', and to pray for salvation in our land. We had decided to stop in Jedburgh for coffee on the way to the border (there must be a Costa somewhere!). As usual for us, we set off really early and by the time we got to Jedburgh there were very few shops open, and so we decided to move onto the border and make a cup of coffee there in Trekeef. We arrived and there at the border there was an enormous stone with Scotland painted on one side and Eng



n the other. Keith prayed and proclaimed what the Lord had told him to do, and then came back to Trekeef for a coffee. As he entered the van a car drew up, and Keith suddenly said 'I want to offer this couple a Bible. He went out to them, to find out they were Christian visitors from Europe and that they were members of the Gideon's. They happily received the Bible as a sign that God's word would run freely

through their country as well as ours. After they had driven off another car drew up and out got a gentleman in kilt and carrying a set of bagpipes. He crossed the road and the first song he played was 'Amazing Grace'! We realised that if we had stayed in Jedburgh for coffee we would have missed all this that God has planned for us.

We then journeyed through England as we made our way back to Land's End, bringing with us some soil from John O'Groats to plant.

Keith was thrilled whilst Trekeef was in Burton upon Trent to have Andy Grice work upon the blisters of paint on the window and side plinth, and to paint up the alloy wheels. Thanks Andy for a first class job, beautiful paint match and application.

We were blessed with many opportunities to preach and share at a number of different venues, to visit places where we had been involved with local churches doing Bible Delivery. At the services which were taken we were encouraged to see people who expressed a desire to follow Jesus in salvation and dedication to the work which Jesus had called them to do.

Monday May the 4th after a 3am start from Cirencester, Trekeef and little focus were on the road again travelling to Land's End for the final leg of the journey. After a couple of Costa stops on the way, they arrived at Escalls Chapel by 10am where they were met by Chris and Lin, and Nigel and Amanda, and together they journeyed to Land's End for the final prophetic act and prayer. Together we prayed, Nigel proclaimed **Isaiah 61**, and Keith planted the soil carried from John O'Groats.

So is that the end of the story, NO, it is just the continuation of taking the Good News of Jesus out into our nation. Praying for salvation, discipleship and commitment across our land as we see our time of opportunity is available. Let us join together to see HIS KINGDOM COME AND HIS WILL BEING DONE ON EARTH AS IT IS IN HEAVEN
