### Reports from around the country

#### Chris and Lin Hunneyball. Shekinah Door to Door Bible Drop

We called morning afternoon and early evening until someone answered the door. If no-one answered we eventually left a testimony leaflet and letter, inviting people to contact the Church if they wanted a Bible.

The team was, Lin and Chris on the doors, joined on one occasion each by Charles, Linda, and Sally. Our prayer team was, at various times, Claire Harvey, Jean, Julie, Lee, Linda, Petrina and Sally. We could not have gone out on the doors without their spiritual back-up. The 'on the door' team compared notes with the prayer team at intervals and it was amazing to see how God was speaking to the intercessors and how it reflected what our on-the-ground experiences were that day with people we met on the doors.

**A total of 574 homes were visited and 439 doors (76%) opened.**

**267 Bibles were given out (61% of those that opened the door).**

**99 people asked for prayer (23% of those that opened the door).**

**135 letters were delivered to those where the door was not opened.**

Future work could involve,

- 1) Following up those who received Bibles and/or prayer, possibly with questionnaires to give feedback.
- 2) Calling on the addresses where no-one ever came to the door. Some of these

seemed empty, for sale or holiday lets, and they might now be occupied.

- 3) Following up people who contact the Church as a result of the letters, so that as well as a Bible, they have the chance for discussion and to receive prayer.

#### Carnhell Green

The team of five have continued working in Gwinear Parish in Cornwall.

They have been encouraged with the continued uptake of Bibles in the next area of the parish.

They have had two teams out one week whilst one of the team stayed and prayed. That session 14 people took Bibles and good conversations were had with the homeowners who opened the doors.

The following week they were down to three on the team and one team went out in the morning and one person prayed, this was changed around at lunch time, and again Bibles were received and conversations held.

#### Cirencester

The team have completed the Bible delivery in the Beeches Estate, but are continuing to have good return visits, and recently a couple of people have begun to attend the New Life Church. They found, initially, that some people had been encouraged to go back to church, having been visited 'on the doors', but they were attending fellowships other than New Life Church. As the church is much bigger than our particular fellowship, the team were thrilled that people were once again fellowshiping in whichever 'church' they were comfortable to worship among.

## Holderness Community Church

They, and we, give thanks for the increase in the labourers 'in the harvest field'. This has been there prayer for a while and the Lord has increased the number of people working in the villages of Holderness.

## An impassioned plea from Keith.

At this time in our nation we are hearing of God moving in wonderful ways in many places, and it is true that at this time the people we are visiting are open to hearing the Gospel, but sadly there are often so few 'labourers in the harvest field'.

**Please pray that the Lord of the Harvest will cause the whole church to become involved in seeking the lost.**

Many years ago the Lord gave me a word which has burned in my soul all my Christian life, and it is,

**Don't count the cost, but the lost!**

Whilst spending time in Stonesfield in Oxfordshire Pauline read the story of the Lost sheep, but this time from Matthew and not the usual story from Luke. She was shocked to read it carefully and realise this is what Jesus says when summing it up,

**When he finds it....he rejoices over it MORE than over the ninety nine which have not gone astray. Matthew 18 vv 12 – 14**

No wonder we declare that grace is Amazing and Outrageous! The Lord rejoices over the returning one MORE than the rest of residing in 'the church'.

What will it 'cost' us to seek those who don't know Jesus and what is it compared with the eternal soul of them?
