Margaret shared "I visited a lady today David and I had called on during the evangelism course with you both, and she's doing very well in her faith. I had a lovely welcome."


Messages like these are so encouraging to us and hopefully to those who read these newsletters and pray for the work of MMM.

A blast from the past!

We would like to share with you some photos concerning work in Bible Delivery from many years ago. Whilst Keith and Pauline were living in Aldbrough, East Yorkshire, they had the privilege of meeting John and Marion Burton. In August 1996 Keith met John at the front of his house, and shared with John a word that the Lord had told Keith to share with a man he would meet on the front of his home.

John gave his life to Jesus and Keith returned home to fetch a Bible for John and one for his wife, Marion. Upon returning with the Bibles Keith

found that Marion knew the Lord, but had not been walking with Him. Keith presented them with the Bibles and when returning to visit in December 2013 John and Marion showed Keith and Pauline the Bibles they had been presented with.



The Lord has promised that His word will not return to Him void without accomplishing that which He has sent it out to do, and we can clearly see this to be true in John and Marion's lives.

And now to the present :-

Acts 1:8 Evangelism Manual

Many of you who have been praying for us over the last year will know that, although we have an Acts 1:8 Evangelism work book which we use when training, we have been involved in seeking to produce a manual which can be used without a Micah rep needing to be present and do the teaching.

For this reason Keith and Pauline headed off to the northern reaches and a six week stay with Ivan

and Heather Knapton and family. This allowed Pauline uninterrupted time to sit and write the manual. This was successful and the manual was written during December and sent electronically to Lynda Lush who has kindly agreed to proof read it. When this arduous task is completed, and the corrections put into the manual, Micah will be seeking to have it produced in whichever manner is considered the most useful. It is hoped; also then to make it available on Kindle which will enable it to be sold at a minimum cost and every 90 days offer it free. This enables Christians in the 3rd World to download the teaching for free.

It is hoped that when the manual is ready for sale to produce a presentation package which will include the manual, the set of DVD's of the teaching and the work book as a complete package. To make this possible, Keith and Pauline are arranging to go again to Dunstable to record a video of the final session and the teaching on Seed Sowing, both of which can be found in the manual but not as yet on DVD. Micah is grateful to Graham Popland and Tim Netherwood for their help with the DVD filming and production.

And onto the future

Now the manual is on the way to being completed does it mean Pauline gets her wish to retire and read the 300 free books she has waiting on her Kindle to read?

Sadly, **NO**, the year is already filling up with bookings for further 5 week training sessions. January and February Keith and Pauline will be involved in a prayer project. They have a firm booking for a further visit to Stonesfield in Oxfordshire, and two possible bookings 'pencilled in' in Cornwall. Another exciting development for 2014 is the proposed trip to Kananga in the Democratic Republic of Congo in June/July with Nigel Clark. Some of you will know that Nigel, and his wife Glyn, have joined the board of Micah Trustees this

year, and they are members and leaders in the Shekinah Fellowship in Penzance which Keith and Pauline have been attending during their time in the Penwith area of Cornwall. The Shekinah Church have for some time now been supporting a work in Kananga, this includes work with a church and attached school.

Nigel is taking a trip out to Kananga in June/July 2014 and he has invited Keith and Pauline to go with him. It will give them opportunity to share in the work there, whatever that may entail! It is also hoped to have opportunity to see if there is any use for the Acts 1:8 Evangelism training, but obviously not in door to door Bible delivery, but the principals in the manual will be of use in all forms of evangelism. There will be further details concerning this in later newsletters.
