One of the most enjoyable ways of implementing the training has been running the training sessions on a weekly basis for ten weeks. We have now had 18 people go through the training and are seeking to use the training in their personal outreach ventures. We include some thoughts from one of the attendees.

I found the Evangelism course both inspiring and challenging. What I gleaned from Acts 1:8 has already helped me enormously in stepping out and sharing my faith and testimony with some of the people I encounter daily. Some who I may not have had the confidence to be so honest with a few months ago. I'm sure all that I gathered will continue to register as I go forward with the faith that I will be part of a new ministry commencing in the New Year. Although of course, learning new spiritual principles or being reminded of ones that perhaps had gravitated to the back of my mind was incredibly useful, I think the main things that I will take away with me are these: Firstly, Keith and Pauline's warmth, hospitality and efforts to create a safe environment where I felt comfortable and trusting to share my experiences and to ask questions without feeling self-conscious. Secondly, meeting new people, spending time with old friends and in short, fellowshiping with a group who clearly loved the Lord. And thirdly, although there was a clearly a programme and a manual to compliment it, the Horobin's allowed it to be spirit led, making room for Jesus whenever there was a clear indication for prophetic words to be shared, prayers to be administered, stories to be told... I would recommend this course to anyone actually. Not just those who are looking to step up their 'evangelism game.' But those seeking to know the Lord more intimately, those who desire cultivating new and old relationships, and anyone desiring an opportunity to grow spiritually and like I said earlier, in a safe and nurturing space-free to be themselves.
