Acts 1:8 Training Manual

Many of you have been praying long and hard concerning the production of the training manual in paper form, and it is with great pleasure, and thanks to the Lord, that we are able to bring you up to date with what He has done.



As most of you are aware, the production of the manual, proof reading and digital placing on Kindle had been completed by the beginning of January.

Then began the work of finding someone to publish, and then print the paper copy. Keith and Pauline were blessed to spend a morning with Kevin Wild of Wild Associates in Long Rock, Penzance, discussing the manual. Kevin inspired them with the possibilities of producing a quality product, and making this available to take the vision, of training many others, out into the Christian world.

Keith, Pauline and Micah's Trustees considered the cost of doing this, and began discussing what was necessary.

Tuesday January the 28th, Pauline had a restless night going over in her mind whether paying for a quality product was what God wanted or whether 'cheap and cheerful' was what He wanted. She believed that if the Lord wanted a quality product He could provide the finance for this, but she did not want to be praying for finance that the Lord was not requiring. She knew what the Lord commissions He pays for! Finally she said to the Lord if you want a quality product please send us a gift of £1,000 to begin the process by February the 1st, 4 days' time!!!!

Thursday evening KnP received an e-mail asking for their phone number, which they replied to, and a little while after this their phone rang. It was a Christian friend who said that they were in the area and would love to come over and have coffee

with them the next day (Friday January the 31st) if they were free. They were free, and welcomed the visit.

The friend arrived and they spent some time sharing on the miraculous way God had provided for the new motorhome. After some time the friend asked if there were any ministry needs at that time, and they replied sharing concerning the production of the manual. Keith shared that the Lord had shown him that the manual was to spread in a similar way to the Alpha course, with printed information, DVD presentations and website information.

At this point the friend said that they had come over to tell Keith and Pauline that they were going to put £5,000 into Micah's account to provide the finance for this venture. They continued by saying that they knew of a Christian publisher in London, and they would send the document to them for a quote. Pauline sent the document digitally to their friend that evening and by 10pm that night received a copy of the e-mail that had been sent to the publisher and the copy of his reply.....

His reply read, 'I have known Keith Horobin since I was a teenager as we attended the same church in Burton upon Trent'

What an amazing God we serve and how wonderfully He answers our prayers. The Lord had not sent Pauline the £1,000 she had asked for to begin the project, but the £5,000 which would complete the project, and someone who knew them with which to work on the project.

And so is it glory all the way..... the scripture in Mark 10:29-30 gives the complete picture,

At the beginning of the year Keith had a loud buzzer fitted to his indicators so that he could be sure that they had cancelled after use. Sometime after this it was noticed that when the set of keys were placed down on a surface in the van, or used to open any of the outside cupboards, the indicators would flash as in 'hazard' mode and the buzzer would sound. This was annoying, but was able to be 'lived with' on the promise that the next

time we took the van for repair we would ask them about it.

That was until Monday February the 24th 9pm, with no one touching any of the keys, the alarm sounded and the lights flashed on and off. This continued approximately every 20 seconds throughout the night until 5am the next morning. Some sleep was achieved with the promise of a trip up to Somerset to the motorhome repair unit as soon as it got light.

From 5am until setting out at 8am the fault only occurred three times, but as soon as we set out along the road it commenced the 20 second alarm, that was until we reached the motorhome repair unit when it stubbornly refused to go again. No fault could be found and KnP stayed overnight, but nothing gave even a peep let alone a full alarm sound.

On the return trip all was well until the van crossed the Tamar, and then once again it gave three beeps, but Praise God from then until now it has been silent. Not a major persecution when compared with others, but very trying and tiring; when sleep is affected.

Isn't it exciting that there is so much the news the diary has had to be shrunk in size, but not in activities the Lord has planned, **please pray.**
