Bible Delivery in St Buryan Cornwall

It has been quite some time since **MMM** has personally arranged Bible Delivery in a Cornish town or village, but since the end of May last year until the middle of February, **MMM** and a team from Shekinah Church, Penzance have been working together to deliver Bibles, and share the Good News of Jesus in the village of St Buryan.



This task has been made so much more encouraging by the support of the local Anglican Church, and its Rector, Reverend Canon Vanda Perrett, and her team of vicars and lay workers.

The Bible delivery team were also encouraged with the Methodist Church requesting and using Bibles for their Bible Study.

During the time of Bible Delivery the team have on occasions visited the church for their Tuesday morning communion service before beginning going out to deliver the Bibles.

KnP were also encouraged to attend and be part of various services over the Christmas period.

They were amazed at the Christingle service at the beginning of December to be present when there was literally 'standing room only', with both the church, choir stalls and Lady Chapel packed to capacity and a large crowd stood at the back.



Keith was privileged to share a reading in the service of Nine Lessons and Carols, and KnP were blessed to attend the Christmas Eve Midnight service, and join with the large crowd there wishing everyone a blessed Christmas.

The Rector, Vanda, knowing that Bibles were being delivered has planned the Lent Course around the Bible; inviting local Anglican dignitaries, including at least 2 Bishops and 2 Archdeacons!, to take a session sharing their favourite book of the Bible and giving the reasons for their choice.

At the end of the delivery time we were thrilled to be able to report that 80% of the people contacted were willing to take a Bible, and some testimony tracts. The last day of February we are going to attend the communion service at St Buryan, and then **onto the village of Madron, another small Cornish village with people who need to hear and know about Jesus.**
