An Evening in Aldbrough

K&P were both born and raised in Burton upon Trent, and it is therefore difficult for them to know who to visit and see whilst they are in the area. Three meetings were planned and some personal visits were made. K&P were privileged to stay with Keith's mother and step father during their time in Burton.

The first meeting took place in a home in Rolleston. There were about 10 of us and it was a thrill for K&P to be able to share with a group of folks, some of whom have been praying for *M.M.M.* since the work began in 2002. It was great to meet up again with Sue Davidson, who has been to Cornwall a number of times to share in the work, and joined with *M.M.M.* for the Mission in St Just in 2005. There was a good time of sharing and time for some questions at the end.

The second meeting was at Kingsway Church, and once again Christians from a number of Churches in Burton came along. Most of the people K&P had met previously and it was good to renew fellowship. At the end of the presentation, Pauline went over to speak to one lady that she thought she had not met before. The lady, named June, said that they had met before as she had attended High St Church where K&P were members many years before. June went on to share of another occasion they had met. In the mid 1980's K&P had sought to reach out into their own village of Tatenhill, and as part of this outreach they had planned an evening Praise and Outreach meeting. K&P had leafleted the three villages in the area of Tatenhill, and arrived ready to take the meeting. They had invited John Tormey, another evangelist to lead the meeting, Pauline was to lead the singing and Keith was to preach. The congregation consisted of June and a non-Christian friend of hers named Betty. Pauline sang her heart out, John led really well, and Keith preached as if there were hundreds there. Betty made a commitment and was baptised in the Holy Spirit, and June was able to tell Pauline that Betty had recently died, but maintained her faith to the end.

Pauline was reminded of a story which she heard Meg Croft tell. A little boy was walking with his grandfather along a sea shore on which were beached

hundreds of starfish. The little boy began throwing the starfish back into the sea. The grandfather said 'what are you doing, can't you see there are hundreds. You won't be able to throw them all back, and it won't make a difference.' The little boy replied 'It will to the one I throw back.' Betty was a one that God called to Himself, because a few people planned an outreach meeting and a friend cared enough to take her along with her. We can all make a difference with everyone that we share with. This instance was a wonderful illustration of what K&P were sharing in Ploughing Sowing and Reaping.

K&P were encouraged at the end of this meeting as David Jevons prayed for them, a gentleman shared a word from the Lord with them, Aileen shared a picture, Dave Hawthorn shared the prophetic, and everyone there shared their love and concern with K&P. Bless the Lord for His Church at work.

The third meeting in Burton took place at Carver Rd Fellowship. K&P have been thrilled to visit Carver Rd Fellowship on a number of occasions, always receiving a warm and genuine welcome, and this was no exception.
