### Report of the work in Cirencester

Annual Report Update of Bible Distribution on Beeches Estate from New Life Church, Cirencester. We have distributed approximately 310 - 320 Bibles since last June 2011. We have seen approximately 10 - 15 people give their lives to Christ and don't know about others who have not reported back to us. As we closed out the summer work in July 2012, we went to a particularly hard spiritual area called the Beeches Grove. We saw God moved mightily and 2 people gave their lives to Christ and over 70 percent of the houses took Bibles or some materials. Praise the Lord!

We recently restarted doing the Bible distribution 27 September 2012. We delivered 10 Bibles in one hour and many other people took tracts and testimonies.

We have been praying about the next place to do Bible distribution and all feel strongly about doing the Chesterton Estate. We are also keen to ask the other churches in Cirencester to get involved and will conduct training through the new DVD for training people on how to do Prophetic Evangelism on the Doors. We are determined to get a Bible into every house in Cirencester that wants one.

We all pray that God is richly blessing you and we will stand with you in prayer in all that you are doing. God says, "Preach the word, be instant in season and out of season, reprove, exhort, and teach with all longsuffering and doctrine because the time will come when they won't endure sound doctrine. Praise God that we can still get the gospel out in this country with freedom.



### Bibles

*Micah* have been able to order a further £15,000 worth of Bibles during September, and the friends at Kingdom Advance Network in Burton upon Trent have kindly offered to store them for *Micah*. The Bibles are NIV Bibles and now have a bright orange cover, the list price on the back of the Bible is £11.99 and *Micah*

is purchasing them at £4 per copy. Therefore purchasing a further 3,750 Bibles. If you are Bible delivering we need to get busy as there are a lot of Bibles there to go.

Please note that the black Bibles, at £3 per Bible, have nearly all gone, and the new Bibles will be £4 per Bible. ### Prayer Groups

KnP were encouraged at the end of September to join with the *Micah* prayer group in Camelford for their half night of prayer for the work of *Micah*. It was during this time that we believe the Lord gave the following word to us, and we believe it has a wider application.



### Prophetic word September 27<sup>th</sup> 2012

I am raising up a standard in the land today, and the Spirit of the Lord is hovering over many waters.

Just like old buildings are dismantled for new buildings to go up, I am dismantling my church from the 'old ways' of thinking. I am dismantling the body of my church and changing mind-sets, so that they may move by the power and anointing of My Holy Spirit. Then they will not carry out the desires of their fleshly and worldly nature.

For the spirit of this age is within the church, and the spirit of this world would seek to take control of My church, but I am coming back for My church as a bride. Therefore, I am changing mind-sets, and doing a deeper work, and taking My church to a deeper level so that they might die to self, and that they might see that it is the cross of Jesus, at Calvary, where He died to self, where He was raised up on the third day into newness of life, that they need to take up.

The old ways and the old systems cannot hold water any longer, and they are they are still trying to use the old systems to hold water; but the Spirit of the Lord is coming with such power where He is changing mind-sets, causing His church to arise from out of those old systems into the new things that God is planning in the body of the church.

As my people start to pray and change their ways of thinking, their ways of reasoning. Let the prayer be praise and prayer, that they will start to praise Me, and glorify My name in the spiritual realm, then I will come with My power and with My might. It is important that

people come to the 'old way', for the way is important. The Gospel never loses its power. For the Gospel shows people the way to go, but there are so many ears that are deaf, for there are so many that want their own way, and to live their lifestyles in their own selfish desires.

For My church to grow and for My church to move forward, people will have to die to self, and that is why, at the moment, you see even within the nations how things are being dismantled, how things are being exposed, and sin is being exposed. Not only within the governmental bodies within the nations am I exposing sin, but also within the governmental bodies within the church. The sins of pride and arrogance, the sins of self-righteousness. I am causing My church to repent, and to start to do what I tell them to do. Reach out to lost souls that are going to a lost eternity. Don't just be satisfied with what is happening to you, but be satisfied to bring souls from darkness into My glorious light. So that the Gospel might be heard, as the Gospel is the power of God unto salvation.

I am turning

And I'm speaking to the body of My church today so that it may be changed. Those changes are important, and those changes will take place. You pray for revival, but the Lord would say revival starts with My people. As My people are changed and as My people are turned around, and inside out, and start to move upon the right way, the Godly way, the way of the cross, which I took, the narrow way. Then you will see a change, you will see a shift, you will see the power of My Holy Spirit coming. You will see miracles within the streets, of people's lives being changed and turned around.

There has been that much fleshly stuff that has been done, not in the name of Jesus, but in the name of mankind. I am coming to change mind-sets, and to turn My church around so that those cisterns will hold water. For this is time of God's favour and this is the time when God will reveal Himself to mankind, where you will see those tears of repentance coming once again as my people humble themselves under the mighty hand of God. Then you will see a change, and you will see a shift in direction in the way My church will choose to go.
