We thank you all for your prayers concerning the Micah Trustees meeting. It was a good time together sharing and planning for the direction in the future.

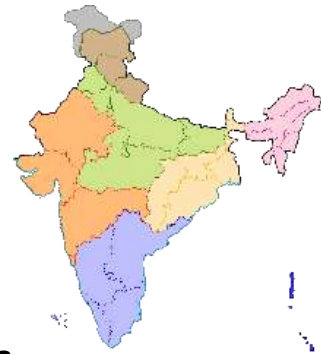
