### The 3 O'clock Prayer Meeting

Matthew 20:5 NLT

So they went to work in the vineyard. At noon and again at three o'clock he did the same thing.

**3 o'clock - the time for work. Prayer is work. Sometimes work can be a blessing and sometimes it can be drudgery, but we don't abandon it at the difficult times. Those called at 3 o'clock were not the last called, but they were second to last. Time is getting short.**

Matthew 27:45-46 NLT

At noon, darkness fell across the whole land until three o'clock. [46] At about three o'clock, Jesus called out with a loud voice, "Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani?" which means "My God, my God, why have you abandoned me?"

**3 o'clock. - In His time of darkness and death Jesus cried out. We as the people of God are in a time of darkness, in this nation and around the world. We need to cry out to God.**

Matthew 27:50-53 NLT

Then Jesus shouted out again, and he released his spirit. [51] At that moment the curtain in the sanctuary of the Temple was torn in two, from top to bottom. The earth shook, rocks split apart, [52] and tombs opened. The bodies of many godly men and women who had died were raised from the dead. They left the cemetery after Jesus' resurrection, went into the holy city of Jerusalem, and appeared to many people.

**3 o'clock - the way to God was opened, there were signs on the earth, and the dead life was resurrected and restored. They returned to the city and their presence was testimony to the amazing event.**

Acts 3:1 NLT

Peter and John went to the Temple one afternoon to take part in the three o'clock prayer service.

**3 o'clock - a time of regular prayer. The disciples were living in the 'glory days' of the outpourings of the Holy Spirit, but they maintained a regular rhythm of prayer.**

Acts 10:3 NLT

One afternoon about three o'clock, he had a vision in which he saw an angel of God coming toward him. "Cornelius!" the angel said.

**3 o'clock - at the regular time of prayer, Peter had the vision. During the regular; the supernatural broke in.**

Acts 10:30 NLT

Cornelius replied, "Four days ago I was praying in my house about this same time, three o'clock in the afternoon. Suddenly, a man in dazzling clothes was standing in front of me.

**3 o'clock - as Cornelius was taking the regular time to pray he has an angelic visitation; bringing instructions. The Lord can speak to one at the same time as another a distance away.**

We believe God would have us to pray at this time, each day for 30 mins, and if you would like to join us we would be blessed to have you along.
