The Horobin's are now fat and sugar free people and working hard at exercise and weight loss. K&P do thank the folks who have prayed for them, and they are pleased to say that Keith is feeling fine and has been able to continue with his study on grace. No doubt we will all hear more about that subject as the year goes by.

Keith returned to see the diabetic nurse the following week. He found out she was a Christian nurse whom he first met when *Micah* arrived in Hayle in 2002. They spent about half the time talking about the diabetes and the other half talking about grace and obedience. He does not have to see the nurse again until early November as he had lost 5lbs in weight and his blood sugar level was well down.

God is good in the way He not only allows us to learn from His word about the things He wants to teach us, but He also allows us into situations which enable us to put into practice that which we have learnt. Keith was preaching a sermon on tape, ready for the website. He was well into the word, when the phone rang disrupting his talk. He started again and got to the last ten minutes when the batteries on the recorder ran out. Pauline thinks God is really into teaching him grace both practically and in theory!!!



### Prayer the best way to get in touch with God

K&P have always appreciated the prayer support they receive from up and down the country including the Duchy of Cornwall. Two people they first met in Cornwall were David and Viv Viols of the Cornwall Prayer Initiative. This group have a rare quality in the fact that their main aim is to encourage small groups who pray for Cornwall that they are not alone. Both K&P are really encouraged by them.

Each week K&P also pray for situations that happen nationally and welcome up to date national prayer requests through Miss Whittaker and the people at Tremore. It occurred to me that every door Keith & Pauline knock on and every contact they make becomes another person to pray for, someone else who is laid on their hearts, another soul to help. Even when they 'finish' knocking the doors, whether it be Hayle, St Just, St Teath, Delabole, etc - the prayer list just gets longer, the burden for souls gets heavier - the ripples go out further... and further. 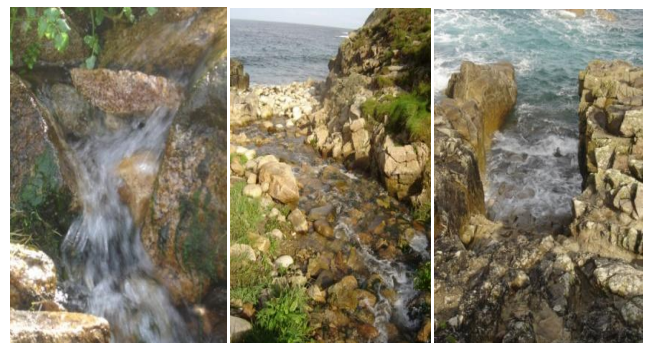
