One beggar telling another beggar where to find bread.




There are many ways to do this, and people filled with the Holy Spirit, radiating the love of Jesus are the best people to do the work.

After attending the local prayer meeting at Shekinah Church the other week, KnP came away thrilled at hearing the ways in which people are reaching out to friends and family with invitations to events at which they will have opportunity to hear about the love and salvation that Jesus offers.

Does this mean that KnP can retire and put the Evangelism Training to 'bed', and what is different about what Micah Mobile Ministries is offering? Well obviously there is nothing different about the Good News that is offered in the work that MMM does, but we do believe it is part of the whole work of evangelism in the nation.

Keith has for many years used the farming illustrations to describe the work of the ministry, and has said MMM is a seed sowing ministry



which it is, but as we were thinking it through we realised that doing door to door work is a little like the work of a 'sub soiler'. Whilst KnP were in Yorkshire the soil was clay soil and became very hard especially when driven over by tractors and combine harvesters, and so before the seed could be sown for the following year a tractor would go across the field sub soiling, that is lifting and breaking up the really hard soil within the field.



A lot of the work of MMM is similar to this. As we approach people who have maybe not really thought about God, and although the majority of people are polite and responsive, their hearts are often hard and the words the Bible distributors bring are like little rakes, lifting and breaking up the soil.

This is another reason why the prayer beforehand, and the prayer support during the work is so important.
