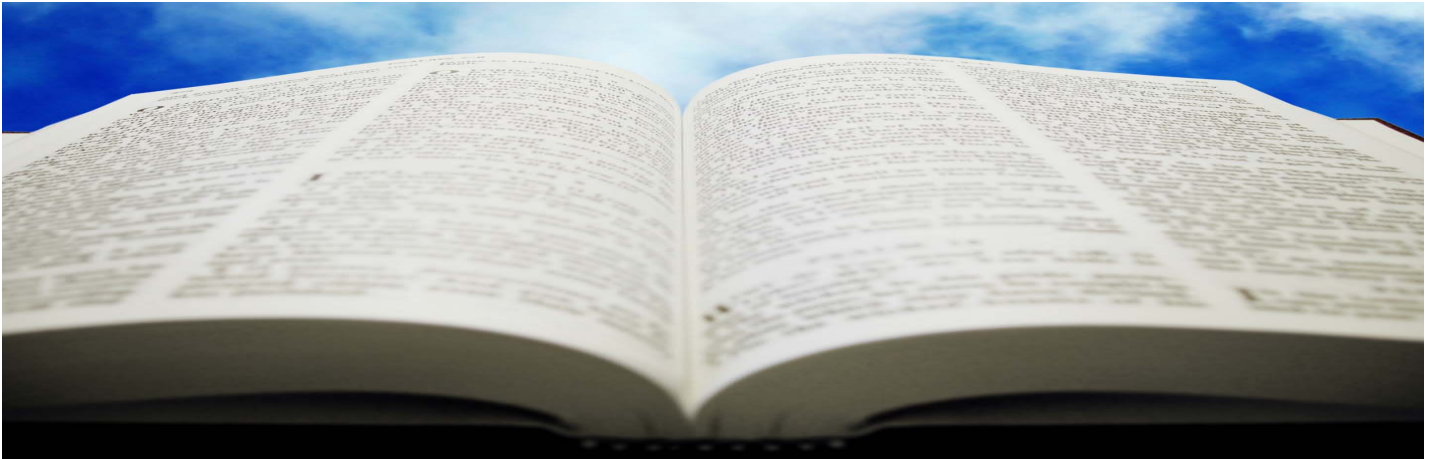

# Read Your Bible In A Year

The Bible is a collection of **66** books. It is divided into two parts the **Old** and the **New Testaments**. The word **Testament** means covenant or agreement. The **Old Testament** contains **39 books**, and the **New Testament** contains **27 books**.

The Bible was written over a period of about **1,500 Years**; by approx **40** different human **authors**. The authors came from very different backgrounds. For example Luke was a doctor, John a fisherman, Moses an Egyptian Prince, and Matthew a tax collector. The authors wrote in different places. For example Moses was in the wilderness, Paul was in prison, and John was in exile. They were written on three different continents; that is Africa, Asia and Europe, and in three different languages. The **Old Testament** was written in **Hebrew** and **Aramaic**, and the **New Testament** in **Greek**. The Bible is God showing Himself to us, and is a record of what God wants us to know about His dealing with mankind. It was written down by people who were **inspired** by the **Holy Spirit**, who is Himself **God**.

The Bible may also be called **the Word of God**, and **the Scriptures**. It has been described as a **sword**, a **hammer**, a **fire**, a **light**, and a **mirror**. Paul one of the **New Testament** writers, says in his book to a man named Timothy that:

All scripture is inspired by God (God breathed), and is useful for teaching, showing us where we are wrong, putting us right and training us in the right way to go.

2 Timothy 3:16

The **Old Testament** may be divided into three main sections: **1. History**, **2. Poetry** and **3. Prophets**.

Genesis to Esther tells the **history** of God's dealings with mankind from the beginning of the world; through the calling, and establishing of the Jewish nation, to the return of the Jewish nation to Israel after their exile to Babylon.

The books of Job to the Song of Solomon, the books of **poetry** tell of God's dealing with one particular man, and contain the 'hymn book' of the Bible, a collection of wise sayings, and a love story.

The books of Isaiah to Malachi are the **prophetic** books; which are books that tell of God's thoughts about the way His people are living.

The **New Testament** can be divided into four parts:- **1. The Gospels. 2. The Acts of the Holy Spirit. 3. The Letters** and **4. Revelation.**

Matthew , Mark, Luke and John give four accounts of the life of Jesus ; which is known as the **Gospel** or **Good News.**

The book of Acts tells of the birth of the church and its early growth through the work of the **Holy Spirit.**

The books of Romans to Jude are **letters** written to churches or individuals by Paul, James, Peter, John and Jude.

The last book is the **revelation** of what will happen to the world as God draws it to a close, and finally wraps up the earth, and the heavens, and makes a new heavens and a new earth.

## **A Thumb nail sketch of each book of the Bible**

### **OLD TESTAMENT.**

- Genesis (Gen.):** Beginnings. This is the book which details the beginnings of all things, the world, mankind, God's choice of a man and a nation.
- Exodus (Exod.):** The nation of Israel is brought out of Egypt, and receives God's instructions in the form of the 10 Commandments and the tabernacle
- Leviticus(Lev.):** God's laws and commands concerning sacrifices, holy days and godly living.
- Numbers(Num.):** The wanderings of the nation of Israel from Egypt to the Promised Land.
- Deuteronomy (Deut.) :** The final reminder from Moses for the Jewish nation before they entered Israel.
- Joshua (Josh.):** The Jewish nation return to the land of Israel after leaving Egypt.
- Judges (Judg):** The Jewish nation is governed by judges.
- Ruth(Ruth):** A gentile woman is brought into the Jewish nation, and is brought into the kingly line of David
- 1 Samuel (1 Sam):** The last of the judges - Samuel, the first of the Kings - Saul and God's choice of King - David
- 2 Samuel (2 Sam):** The reign of King David.
- 1 Kings (1Kings):** The reign of Solomon, the division of the kingdom, and as far as King Ahab. The ministry of the prophet Elijah.
- 2 Kings (2Kings):** The continuation of the Kings up until the taking of Israel into exile in Babylon. The ministry of Elisha.

## **1 Chronicles**

**(1 Chron):** The reign of King David.

## **2 Chronicles**

**(2 Chron):** The reigns of King Solomon up to the exile into Babylon

**Ezra (Ezra):** The return of the Jews to the land of Israel.

**Nehemiah (Neh):** The return of the Jews to the land of Israel.

**Esther (Esth):** The saving of the Jewish nation. Purim.

**Job (Job):** God's dealing with one man; who did not understand the workings of the Almighty God.

**Psalms (Ps):** The hymn book of the Bible.

**Proverbs (Prov):** Wise sayings.

## **Ecclesiastes**

**(Eccles):** The thoughts of King Solomon.

## **Song of Solomon**

**(Song Sol.):** A love story, and love poem.

**Isaiah (Isa):** A prophet who warned Israel before the exile into Babylon.

**Jeremiah (Jer):** A prophet who prophesied as Israel was taken into exile.

## **Lamentations**

**(Lam):** A 'song' of sorrow concerning the state of Israel.

**Ezekiel (Ezek.):** A prophet of the time of the exile.

**Daniel (Dan):** A prophecy of the End Times.

**Hosea (Hos.):** A prophet who God called to marry a prostitute to show how Israel had forsaken the Lord her God.

**Joel (Joel):** A prophet who warned of a coming plague of locusts who would bring God's judgement.

**Amos (Amos):** A prophet who God appointed to bring his word to the nation of Israel during the reign of King Uzziah.

**Obadiah (Obad):** A prophet who foretold of Edom's destruction because of their treatment of Israel and their sin of pride.

**Jonah (Jon):** A prophet sent to Nineveh.

**Micah (Mic):** A prophet who was sent to warn Israel and Judah.

**Nahum (Nah):** A prophet sent to warn about Nineveh.

**Habakkuk (Hab):** A prophet who saw the dangers of the Chaldeans and could not understand God using a godless nation to punish his people, Israel.

**Zephaniah (Zeph):** A prophet sent to warn of judgement on Judah.

**Haggai (Hag):** A prophet who was sent to warn the people about the danger of putting their needs before what God has asked them to do.

**Zechariah (Zech):** A prophet who wrote for Israel after the exile into Babylon.

**Malachi (Mal):** A prophet who wrote to Israel warning them of 'selling God short'

- James (Jas.):** Letter written by a leader of the church in Jerusalem; thought to have been a half - brother of Jesus.
- 1 Peter (1 Pet):** Letter written by the disciple Peter.
- 2 Peter (2 Pet):** Second letter written by the disciple Peter.
- 1 John (1John):** Letter written by the disciple John.
- 2 John (2 John):** Second letter written by the disciple John.
- 3 John (3 John):** Third letter written by the disciple John.
- Jude (Jude):** Letter written by a brother of James, and thought to be a half - brother of Jesus.
- Revelation (Rev):** Written by John, and telling of the things which are to come at the close of the world.
